



John's Meadow

Directions:

Take the 10 Fwy West or the 215 Fwy North to Redlands and take the HWY 38 exit to Angeles Oaks. Follow HWY 38 to Jenks Lake Road (approx. 23 miles from the freeway). Follow the road for about a third of a mile and turn right for another half mile to the Forsee Creek trailhead. Use the Big Bear Lake topo for this area.

The trail leads uphill through the forest for a quarter mile to the trail junction. Go right, West, as the trail follows the San Geronio Wilderness boundary to the Stetson Creek crossing. Note that once you leave the junction the trail to John's Meadow is not shown on the topo as of the '94 revision. John's Meadow is shown on the topo and the trail reaches it where Forsee Creek is joined by a smaller tributary. The elevation gain is only about 300 feet with a distance of 2.7 miles one way. Forsee Creek is a reliable source of water when many of the other creeks in the area have dried up.
